Day-by-Day in Detail

Monday, July 28th - We will depart this morning and arrive in Geneva-on-the-Lake for a delicious lunch at Old Firehouse Winery. Additional free time has been allotted to explore this mini-lakeside resort town and enjoy the beachfront views. Then, continue north to the Canadian border; You **must** have your valid passport book or passport card on your person (i.e. not packed in your bag under the bus). Upon arrival at the Sheraton Fallsview Hotel, we will check-in and the remainder of the evening is at your leisure.

<u>Tuesday, July 29th</u> - Following breakfast, meet with our local guide in the hotel lobby. They will provide a narrated tour of the Niagara Falls area, including Clifton Hill & Queen Victoria Park, for spectacular views of the Canadian & American Falls. Travel along the parkway and see the Greenhouse & Butterfly Conservatory, Niagara Gorge, Sir Adam Beck Generating Station (with a stop at the Floral Clock) & Welland Canal. Continue to Skylon Tower and glide smoothly to the top to experience amazing views of the Falls, Great Gorge, Niagara Wine Country, plus skyline views of Buffalo & Toronto, from the indoor/outdoor Observation Deck. After free time in Clifton Hill for lunch on your own, rejoin the group and continue to Journey Behind the Falls, where you'll experience the awesome spectacle of 20% of the world's fresh water crashing down into the basin below. During summer daylight hours, over 2,800 cubic meters of water thunders over the brink *every second*, traveling over 40 miles per hour! Go from behind the Falls to below them on an exciting Hornblower Cruise. This unforgettable journey offers spectacular views of the Niagara Gorge, American Falls and Bridal Veil Falls, culminating in an up-close encounter with the iconic Canadian Horseshoe Falls. Return to the hotel to freshen up before departing for a delicious & mystical dinner at Greg Frewin Theater. This is a breathtaking, Vegas-style show and features illusions that are both one-of-a-kind and internationally renowned, performed by the International Grand Champion of Magic, Greg Frewin.

Wednesday, July 30th - After breakfast, travel a few miles north to Niagara-on-the-Lake. Nestled in the corner of the Niagara region, the picturesque Niagara-on-the-Lake epitomizes old town charm. Known by the locals as NOTL, the must-visit village is bordered on both sides by waterfront with arbor-framed streets, among lush boulevard gardens. A local step-on guide will meet the group and lead a city tour with stops at historical sites. Following the tour, enjoy time at leisure to stroll the village, shop, and enjoy lunch on your own. Later this afternoon, enjoy a wine flight (at the first of two winery stops) at Palatine Hills Estate Winery. This hidden gem has been tucked away from the beaten path since 1972. Our final stop will be at Trius Winery & Restaurant for a wine-tasting experience followed by an included dinner & wine pairing. Return to the hotel this evening with a full stomach and intoxicating memories!

<u>Thursday, July 31st</u> - Following breakfast & hotel check-out, depart for Greenville. *We will be once again crossing an international border so be sure to have your passport on your person.* Rest & meal stops will be made en route and we will arrive home early this evening.
